

Spring Term



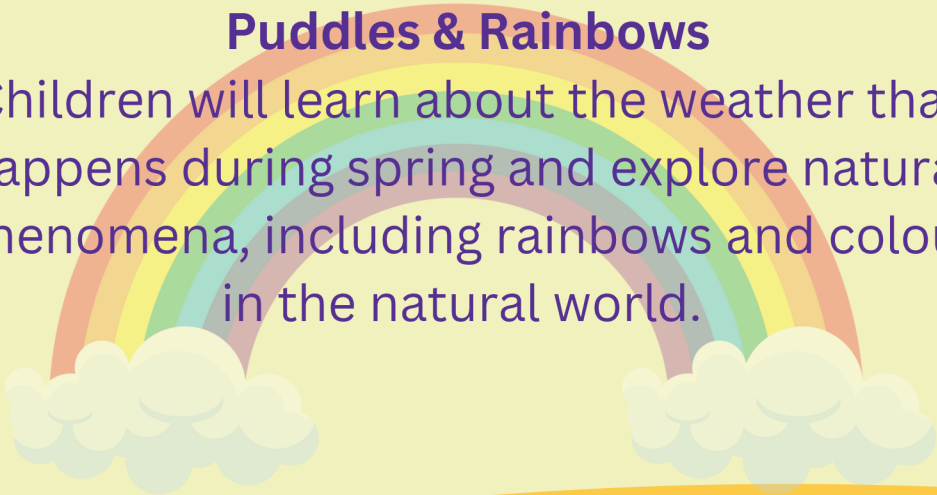
Winter Wonderland

Your child will learn about the changes that happen during winter, including the types of weather associated with winter. They will also explore places that have snow all year round and the types of animals that live there.

Children will learn about the weather that happens during spring and explore natural phenomena, including rainbows and colour in the natural world.



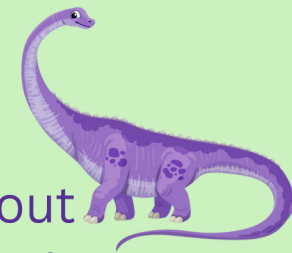
Starry Night

child will explore the differences in the world at night compared to during the day. They will learn about the importance of a good night's sleep, and help them to discover what is happening in the world while they are sleeping, including finding out about nocturnal animals.

This project teaches children about the different animals that roamed Earth millions of years ago and how they are related to animals that live on Earth today.





Areas of Learning

Communication and Language: Engage in conversations about stories and explore the meanings of new words that they hear in stories, rhymes and poems. Listen to others when 1:1 or in a small group, and start and continue a conversation.

Literacy: Joining in with rhyme, rhythm and song. Using roleplay to act out and perform stories.

Mathematics: Numbers 3 to 10, subitising, counting, height and length, mass, capacity

Physical Development: Experiment with different ways of moving the body and begin to remember sequences and patterns of movement

Personal Development: Talk about their own interests, needs and opinions, healthy eating

Expressive design and the arts: rhyme, rhythm and singing songs, printing, cooking and tasting fresh foods

Knowledge and understanding of the world: Main topic
