

Summer Term

Sunshine and Sunflowers

Your child will explore the local environment and see how it has changed over the year. They will grow flowers, fruit and vegetables in the garden area. They will learn how to care for plants and animals, identifying some different types. They take part in outdoor learning and find out how to stay safe in the sun.



Shadows and Reflection

Your child will learn about shadows, reflections and echoes. They will find out how shadows are formed and how they change shape and size during the day. They will explore how different materials and surfaces reflect light.

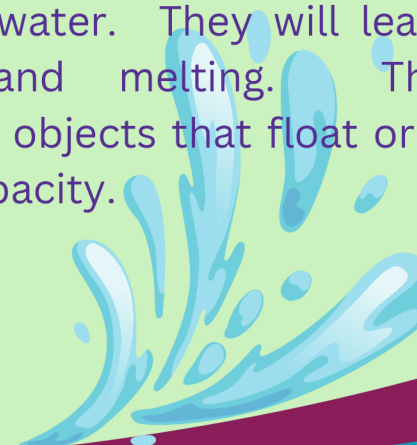


Big Wide World

Your child will find out about the world in which they live. They will learn about different climates and explore habitats. They will locate the United Kingdom on a world map and compare life in the UK with life elsewhere. They will learn about caring for their environment, both locally and beyond.

Splash!

Your child will explore water play and learn about the different forms and bodies of water. They will learn about freezing and melting. They will investigate objects that float or sink and explore capacity.





Areas of Learning

Communication and Listening: Listening to others when 1:1 or in a small group, and start and continue a conversation with a friend for many turns.

Literacy: Engage in conversations about stories and, with support, make links to other familiar stories. Initial sounds and blending.

Mathematics: sequencing, positional language, more and fewer, 2D and 3D shape, numbers to 5

Physical Development: Developing running, developing throwing with precision, following instructions, sports afternoon

Personal Development: Dealing with conflict, how have they changed over time, families

Expressive design and the arts: cookery skills, exploring different instruments

Knowledge and understanding of the world: Main topic
